Prof. John Barnabas (1929-1994)

(Renowned evolutionary biologist and pioneer in molecular systematics)

His work in molecular systematics, hemoglobin evolution, and phylogenetics shaped modern evolutionary science. He held postdoctoral positions at Yale, Groningen, and Georgetown, and headed the Division of Biochemical Sciences at the National Chemical Laboratory, Pune. He was the founder of PG School of Biological Studies, Ahmednagar College

Key Contributions

- Developed methods for measure evolutionary distances using amino acid sequences
- Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize (1974) for contributions to biological sciences
- Fellow of INSA, IAS, and NASI, and Distignuished fellow of CSIR at NCL, Pune.
- Advisor to national scientific bodies: CSIR, DBT, ISRO, and the Govt. of India
- Founder of the Mahabaleshwar Seminar Series (with TIFR & IISc)
